



## VBS Volunteer Descriptions

*“Our goal is to shine Jesus’ light and love to 200 children at VBS. Right now we have enough volunteers to reach 50 kids. How can you help?”*

### **Stellar Bible Adventures**

*Lead children through incredible and interactive learning activities that make the Bible stories come alive in sessions of Stellar Bible Adventures each day. Find the light of the world when Jesus was born. Climb a tree and discover how Jesus’ light changed Zacchaeus’ heart. Have a praise parade to celebrate King Jesus. Use lights to explore how Jesus’ death and resurrection change us...forever! Help each other read a confusing message, just as Philip helped the Ethiopian.*

### **Jr Crafts/Imagination Station (kinder & 1<sup>st</sup> graders)**

*Use the daily Bible Point often as you lead sessions of Imagination Station every day, and help kids connect the fun crafts & experiments to Bible truths.*

### **KidVid Cinema**

*Introduce our daily KidVid Stories and then send kids out with thought-provoking questions to discuss with their crews.*

### **All Star Games**

*Check out all the awesome game options in the All-Star Games Leader Manual, and choose two games for each day. Lead Crews in the fun at sessions of All-Star Games each day*

### **Galactic Snacks**

*Setup and serve snack to our hungry kids each morning!*

**Elementary Crew Leaders** – *Crew Leaders have very little prep each day; just look over your schedule and activities for each day, then guide your Crew members through activities, help facilitate discussions, and generally join in the VBS fun.*

**Preschool Crew Leaders** – *Preschool Crew Leaders play with the children, guide them during activities, and keep them together when they leave the room.*

### **Preschool Exploration Station**

• *Set up the activities for free-choice Exploration Stations such as Galaxy Dough Stars, building block rockets, moon sand goodies, sky high planets, puzzles and more!*

**Preschool Craft Leaders** – *Lead kids at Craft & Play each day as they make flying comets, a sun catcher, moon rocks, and more!*

**Hospitality Team** – *Prepare and serve refreshments to our hard working volunteers!*

**Decorating Team** – *Help us decorate and transform the building into an intergalactic adventure!*

## BIBLE BASICS

Each day, kids will learn a Bible Point that corresponds to a Bible story and key Bible verse. The chart below shows the Bible content kids will cover each day. If you usually incorporate Bible memory verses into your program, you can have kids memorize the key verses provided in this chart. At each station, kids will be carefully listening for the Bible Point. They get to complete the Bible Point by saying, "...shine Jesus' light!" as they fling out their fingers like stars. Watch their excitement and enthusiasm—and listening skills—build throughout the week.



**"Shine Jesus' light!"**

		Bible Point	Bible Story	Bible Verse
DAY 1	 Cosmo	<b>When life feels dark, shine Jesus' light!</b>	Jesus comes as a baby to be king. (Luke 2:1-20; Matthew 1:18-2:12)	"Jesus...said, 'I am the light of the world.'" (John 8:12)
DAY 2	 Ringo	<b>When people don't get along, shine Jesus' light!</b>	Jesus accepts Zacchaeus. (Luke 19:1-9)	"Live in harmony with each other." (Romans 12:16)
DAY 3	 Luna	<b>When good things happen, shine Jesus' light!</b>	Jesus enters Jerusalem as a king. (Luke 19:28-40)	"Shout with joy to the Lord, all the earth!" (Psalm 100:1)
DAY 4	 Sol	<b>When people are sad, shine Jesus' light!</b>	Jesus cares for his mother during his crucifixion. (John 19-20)	"Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God." (John 14:1)
DAY 5	 Halley	<b>When people need help, shine Jesus' light!</b>	Philip helps the Ethiopian. (Acts 8:26-39)	"Let your good deeds shine...so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father." (Matthew 5:16)
